For the first six months of this year, we received on an average \$27,302 per month in General Fund. We anticipate more expenses in the second half of the year because of, for example, Community Day, Fall Camp, Awana and salary to be paid to the new pastor Rev. Lam Wing Keung. If the financial situation continues, it will affect various ministries development. We urge brothers and sisters to pray for the financial situation of CAC.
